## PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

## Housing + Services

Supportive housing is affordable rental housing with access to voluntary supportive services that help vulnerable persons establish and maintain housing stability and include access to activities of daily living and community-based services.



#### **Housing Principles**

- Considered "permanent"
- Housed as quickly as possible; low barrier; few or no preconditions; (Housing First)
- Integrated into the community
- Tenant is offered choices
- Tenant has a standard lease, not required to participate in a program as a condition of housing

#### **Services Principles**

- Voluntary participation
- Community-based or provided on site
- Tailored to each tenant's needs so that he or she can live independently in the community
- Trauma Informed
- Harm Reduction



## RESIDENT EMPOWERMENT

As a nonprofit, Ability Housing is focused on the outcomes of the residents; our goal is for the housing we provide to be a springboard for the residents achieving their goals for their families. To that end, we provide many services, for residents and the community.

Among the services and programming provided are:

- Free Montessori-like preschool
- Onsite satellite health clinic and services
- Accessing benefits
- After school tutoring and activities
- Summer youth camp
- Youth mentoring
- Workforce/career development
- Homeownership assistance
- Crime prevention and neighborhood watch
- Adult and youth literacy
- Budgeting, credit and financial literacy
- Tax preparation assistance
- Food assistance
- Leadership development
