

A WORD FROM THE CHAIR

April brings growth and renewal as we enjoy the mild temperatures before summer arrives. This month, we will focus on training and education. A biannual member training will take place on April 21st from 2 – 4 p.m. The training teaches members how to participate in the planning processes, updates them on legislative and policy changes, and refreshes them on local rules and procedures. The training is a requirement of members, but is open to the public. No business will take place during the training. There will also be a training on the priority setting and resource allocation (PSRA) process in April. PSRA is the primary legislative responsibility of the Planning Council and it requires input and participation from the public. The date and time is to be determined (TBD) at this time. - <u>Grants</u> Resources to help manage a RWHAP grant, including information on reporting requirements; clinical care guidelines and quality of care resources; the performance measures portfolio; and policy notices and program letters.
- <u>Data</u> RWHAP-related data, slide decks, reports, and tools, including the RWHAP Compass Dashboard.
- Resources RWHAP resources, including fact sheets, infographics, expert panel summaries, webinar recordings, newsletters, and the eLibrary.
