

# PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS:** The Pop Warner Super Bowl, which held its 62nd annual tournament the first week of December, invites youth football teams from around the United States to compete in Orlando for the national title in one of three divisions, separated by age/weight classifications. To earn a spot in the tournament, each team has won both their league and regional championships; and

**WHEREAS:** On the road to the Division Three Jr. Pee Wee Super Bowl, Jacksonville's own Grand Park Trojans first became the Greater Jacksonville Pop Warner City Champions, and then Southeast Regional Champions; and

**WHEREAS:** This 20-member squad of 10- and 11-year-olds showed their skills throughout an undefeated regular season and championship run. Their Super Bowl appearance included two shutout performances; and

**WHEREAS:** In the semifinal matchup against the Four Points Vipers White of Texas, the Trojans scored 33 unanswered points. The final match, against the North Raleigh Bulldogs of North Carolina, notched another 13 points and a national title for Grand Park.
