## I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair M. Tuohy called the meeting to order at 3:48 p.m. A quorum was confirmed.

# II. ACTION ITEMS

## **CONSIDERATION OF MEETING MINUTES FOR JANUARY 10, 2024**

A MOTION WAS MADE BY ADVISORY BOARD VICE CHAIR S. MATCHETT AND SECONDED BY ADVISORY BOARD MEMBER BANDELE ONASANYA APPROVING THE RENEW ARLINGTON CRA ADVISORY BOARD JANUARY 10, 2024, MEETING MINUTES, AS AMENDED. THE MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY 5-0-0.

## **CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATION FOR REZONING TO PUD 2023-0425**

Representative of the applicant, Mr. Charles Blumstein, reported that the application has been updated since the last meeting and that the property owner is ready to continue. Mr. Wheeler stated that if they were to recommend approval, there would be a list of conditions that the applicant would need to be meet for it to be in compliance with the RA Zoning Overlay.

Mr. Wheeler continued to provide the six conditions and recommendations that must be included in the PUD Modifications to ensure consistency with the RA/CRA Plan and Overlay. Mr. Wheeler also provided conditions that would support a recommendation of denial as an option to approval.

After a brief discussion of the Board with Ms. Cox and the applicant, the Advisory Board opted to recommend approval with the six conditions.

Chair M. Tuohy opened the floor for public comments. There were no speakers.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY ADVISORY BOARD MEMBER WADE ALLIANCE AND SECONDED BY ADVISORY BOARD MEMBER BANDELE ONASANYA THAT THE RA/CRA RECOMMEND APPROVAL WITH CONDITIONS FOR REZONING TO PUD 2023-0425. THE MOTION PASSED 4-1-0. (VICE CHAIR S. MATCHETT VOTED IN OPPOSITION OF THE MOTION.)
