brain that controls balance and coordination. The defects create pressure on the cerebellum and brain stem, restricting the normal flow

of cerebral spinal fluid to and from the brain; and

WHEREAS: Symptoms usually appear during adolescence or early adulthood and

can include severe head and neck pain, vertigo, muscle weakness, balance problems, blurred or double vision, difficulty swallowing, and

sleep apnea; and

WHEREAS: The cause of Chiari Malformation is unknown; however, scientists

believe that it is either a congenital condition caused by exposure to harmful substances during fetal development, or that can be a genetic

condition, as it may appear in more than one family member; and

WHEREAS: The National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke is

conducting research to find solutions to Chiari Malformation and identify its cause to create improved treatment and prevention plans;

and

WHEREAS: Chiari Malformation Awareness Month is an opportunity to increase

awareness about the signs and symptoms of this disorder and support

research efforts to find additional treatments.
