

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the City of Jacksonville, Duval County; amending Chapter 87-471, Laws of Florida; adding a special zone in Jacksonville to provide an exception for space and seating requirements for a liquor license for the Casbah Cafe; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Chapter 87-471, Laws of Florida is amended to read:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 561.20(1), Florida Statutes, in the area described as follows:

Lots One (1), Two (2), three (3) and Four (4) of B. J. Skinner's Subdivision, of Block Three (3) of Diterich's Subdivision of part of the Hutchinson Grant, according to Plat recorded in Plat Book 8, Page 14, of the current public records of Duval County, Florida.

Parcel Identification Number: a portion 078496-0000

Otherwise referenced herein as the "Casbah Cafe," and having an address of 3628 Saint Johns Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida, 32205, the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the Department of Business Regulation may issue a special alcoholic beverage license to the Casbah Cafe. Such license is conditioned upon the Casbah Cafe containing all the necessary equipment and supplies and serving full course meals regularly and having accommodations at all times for service of 100 or more patrons at tables and occupying not less than 1,800 square feet of floor space which derives no less than 51 percent of gross income per annum from the sale of food consumed on the premises; provided that such licenses shall be subject to local zoning requirements setting distance requirements between liquor-serving establishments and churches and schools and to any provision of the alcoholic beverage laws of the State and rules of the division not inconsistent herewith.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
