

  Industry, Government and Commerce


# Project focuses on DCHD Health Zone 1

- ➤ Health Statistics are Concerning. The worst for nearly every health statistic except suicide. 2<sup>nd</sup> lowest.


#### Concerns Identified by Residents





# Parking Lot Infiltration Areas
