Irrigation

Florida's water is running out, and Jacksonville residents, businesses and utilities must do their share to save our supply. To help with local conservation efforts, Ordinance Chapter 366 states that everyone must follow the schedule and irrigation requirements below:

March-November (Daylight Savings Time)

- No watering from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Odd number addresses or those ending with N-Z or no address may water on Wed and Sat
- Even number addresses or those ending with A-M may water on Thurs and Sun
- Non-residential addresses may water on Tues and Fri
- Apply up to 3/4-inch or less of water each cycle

November-March (Standard Time)

- No watering from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Odd number addresses, or those ending with N-Z or no address may water on Sat
- **Even** number addresses or those ending with **A-M** may water on **S**un
- Non-residential addresses may water only on Tues
- Apply up to 3/4-inch or less of water one time per week
