**FINAL JUDGMENT OF SIMPLIFIED DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE**

This cause came before this Court for a hearing on the parties' Petition for Simplified Dissolution of Marriage. The Court, having reviewed the file and heard the testimony, makes these findings of fact and reaches these conclusions of law:

- A. The Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties.
- B. At least one party has been a resident of the State of Florida for more than 6 months immediately before filing the Petition for Simplified Dissolution of Marriage.
- C. The parties have no minor or dependent children born of the marriage or adopted during the marriage and the wife is not pregnant.
- D. The marriage between the parties is irretrievably broken.
- E. Marital Settlement Agreement.
