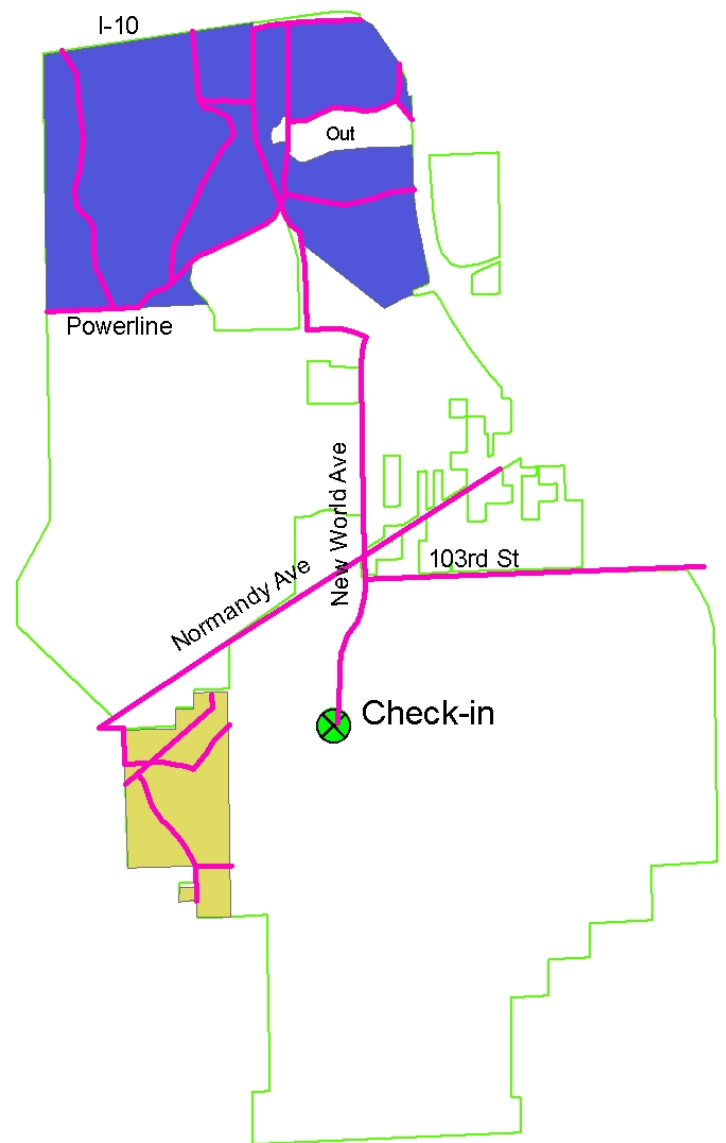


Cecil Commerce Center Public Hunt Areas

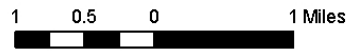


Legend

Cecil Commerce Center contains approximately 12,000 acres of pine flatwoods, cypress and gum swamps, bottomland hardwoods and wiregrass sand hills.

Approximately 3,350 acres of this property (see map) are opened to public hunting as directed by an inter-governmental management agreement between the City of Jacksonville, The Jacksonville Aviation Authority and the Florida Division of Forestry. Cecil Commerce Center forest lands are managed using a multiple-use concept that includes timber, wildlife, water, flora and fauna and recreation.

PERMITS, STAMP AND LICENSE INFORMATION

Individuals accessing Cecil Commerce Center for the purpose of hunting are required to have appropriate Florida licenses, stamps and permits.

Individuals accessing this property for the purpose of hunting must have in his/her possession a Cecil Commerce Center Access Permit and a Florida Hunting License, or Resident Senior Citizen Hunting and Fishing License Certificate. An archery permit, a muzzleloading gun permit and a turkey stamp are also required during designated statewide/zonal seasons.

Applications for access permits for participation in archery, muzzleloading, general gun, and mobility impaired hunts will be accepted beginning at 10:00 AM and selected by random drawing at 12:00 Noon on **Saturday, Sept. 5, 2009 at the Fla. Division of Forestry Jacksonville District Office Bryceville, Fla.** Hunters must be present at the drawing in order to be selected. Access permits will be issued after the drawing. **Ten** access permits will be issued for each access period during the archery, muzzleloading, and general gun seasons and for the access period designated for mobility-impaired hunters taking place during the antlered deer season.

Applications for the spring turkey hunt will be drawn in the same manner described above, on **February 20, 2010**. **Ten** access permits will be issued for each spring turkey hunt.

Hunters may apply either individually or in groups of no more than three persons, but not both. A group application with three hunters will fill three of the **ten** available permits for a given access period.

A fee of \$30.00(15.00 for Mobility Impaired) will be charged for all permits.

ACCESS PERIODS

Archery: **OCT. 3-4, 2009** and **Oct, 17-18, 2009**

Muzzleloading Gun: **Nov. 7-8, 2009**

Mobility - Impaired: **Dec. 5-6, 2009**

General Gun (**Shotgun Only**) **Dec. 12-13, 2009**

Spring Turkey: **Mar. 20-21, 2010, Apr. 10-11, 2010**

Legal to take:

Statewide bag limits established by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission apply for all game.

GENERAL HUNTING REGULATIONS

All general laws and regulations relating to fish and wildlife shall apply unless specifically accepted for Cecil Commerce Center. Access for the purpose of hunting or taking wildlife on Cecil Commerce Center shall be allowed only during designated access periods and in the manner set forth herein:

1. During access periods, public access is restricted to those individuals with valid access permits and one non-hunting companion.
2. All hunters must **check in and out at the Division of Forestry Cecil field office** 6112 New World Ave
3. Driving metal objects into any tree or hunting from any tree in which a metal object has been driven is prohibited.
4. No person shall destroy, cut or remove any trees (including cabbage palm) from Cecil Commerce Center without written permission from the Division of Forestry.
5. It is unlawful for any person to leave garbage, refuse or in any way litter this property.
6. Any person hunting deer or accompanying another person hunting deer shall wear at least 500 square inches of daylight fluorescent orange material above the waistline as an outer garment. This is not required when hunting during the archery-only season.

7. Authorized hunting equipment may be taken on the area by hunt permit holders between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM the day before each hunting period and shall be removed by one half-hour after sunset the last day of the hunting period.
8. Non-migratory game may be hunted from one-half hour before sunrise until one-half hour after sunset.
9. It is unlawful to set fire to any marsh, forest, grass or woodlands or for any individual or group of individuals to build a warming fire or campfire and leave same un-extinguished (Chapter 590, FS).
10. The head and evidence of sex may not be removed from the carcass of any deer or turkey on the property.
11. No person shall release any wildlife on this property.

MOBILITY IMPAIRED HUNTERS

Mobility impaired hunters must have a Mobility Impaired Eligibility Certification from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission before making the application for a hunt permit.

No more than two non-disabled helpers may accompany a mobility impaired permit holder.

The non-disabled helpers are not eligible to hunt or possess firearms during the general gun for mobility-impaired hunt

Personal vehicles and all-terrain vehicles may be used by mobility-impaired hunters and are not restricted to named or numbered roads.

GUNS AND DOGS

1. Possession of dogs is not permitted on this property during designated access periods except that bird dogs may be possessed and dogs under restraint may be used to track wounded game.
2. **Shotguns** or bows are allowed only during established hunting seasons.
3. No person shall have a gun or bow in manual possession while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

VEHICLES

1. Vehicles may be operated on designated roads only.
2. Vehicular access is permitted on all designated scouting days. Scouting is allowed from 8:00 AM until 5:00 PM the weekend prior to any scheduled hunt. All hunters must check in at the Cecil Commerce Center Division of Forestry office prior to entering the area for scouting purposes.
3. Vehicles may not be parked in such a manner that obstructs roads, gates or fire lines.

SEARCH

A wildlife officer, Jacksonville Sheriff's Officer, Department of Agriculture Law Enforcement Officer or other Cecil Commerce Center security personnel may search any vehicle or camp if he/she believes a violation has been committed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Defacing, molesting or destroying signs or other property on Cecil Commerce Center is punishable by law.
2. Anyone born on or after June 1, 1975 must have passed a Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission approved hunter safety course prior to being issued a hunting license and permit.
3. This map is to be used for reference only, not for navigational or survey purposes. Please obey all posted signs and property boundaries.
4. Please respect the location of other hunters.
5. Division of Forestry management of Cecil Commerce Center forestlands includes prescribed burning most months of the year. For personal safety reasons, hunters should contact the Division of Forestry for information and location of burn areas.
