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Jacksonville Area Florida Department of Transportation Lane Closings

October 31 through November 6

I-10/I-95 interchange reconstruction project

I-95 northbound within the project limits WILL BE TOTALLY CLOSED nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. from Monday, November 2 through Wednesday, November 4. Detour signs will be posted. I-95 southbound within the project limits WILL BE TOTALLY CLOSED from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. from Wednesday, November 4 through Saturday, November 7. Detour signs will be posted. The movement to I-95 northbound from Stockton Street is closed until approximately the winter of 2011. Lane closings may occur at various locations within the project limits on I-10 and I-95 and on the side streets between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. The anticipated completion time for this project is early 2011.

I-10 resurfacing and widening project between Lane Avenue and Halsema Road

Single lanes in both directions on I-10 may be closed next week at various locations within the project limits between 6:30 p.m. and 6 a.m. from Monday, November 2 through Thursday, November 5. Single lanes on Chaffee Road near I-10 may be closed in both directions nightly from 7:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. from Sunday, November 1 to Thursday, November 2. This project is scheduled to be completed in the spring of 2012.

I-10 pavement improvement project between Stockton Street and Lane Avenue

Lanes are scheduled to be closed nightly in both directions between 6:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. from Monday, November 2 through Friday, November 6. This project is scheduled for completion in the spring of 2012.

I-10 just east of U.S. 301

Various lanes will be closed in both directions on Thursday, November 5 between 8:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. for routine bridge maintenance.

I-95/ S.R. 9A east interchange reconstruction near the Jacksonville International Airport

I-95 northbound and southbound and ramps within the project limits WILL BE TOTALLY CLOSED on various nights between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. from Monday, November 2 through Friday, November 6. Detour signs will be posted. The new flyover ramp from I-95 south to S.R. 9A east should be finished in the fall of 2010.

I-295 at Collins Road

I-295 southbound WILL BE TOTALLY CLOSED from 11 p.m. on Monday, November 2 until 5 a.m. on November 3. I-295 northbound WILL BE TOTALLY CLOSED from 11 p.m. on Tuesday, November 3 until 5 a.m. on Wednesday, November 4. Detour signs will be posted. Construction of an overpass is occurring.

I-295 over the Buckman Bridge

Single lanes will be closed in both directions between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. from Monday, November 2 through Friday, November 6 for roadway maintenance activities.

Hart Bridge repainting and structural repair project

The bridge will be open to traffic for the Florida/Georgia football game weekend on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Full bridge closings will occur Monday through Thursday nights from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. and on weekends from 7 p.m. on Friday until 6 a.m. on Monday. Single lane closings will occur during non-rush hour times. Northbound lane closings can occur between 9 a.m. and 7 p.m. and southbound lane closings can occur between 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. This work should be finished in early 2011.

Atlantic Boulevard bridge over the San Pablo River (ICW)

One eastbound lane will be closed daily between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, November 3 and Wednesday, November 4 for a routine bridge inspection.

Beach Boulevard just west of Parental Home Road

Lanes will be closed in both directions on Wednesday, November 4 from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. for routine bridge maintenance.

Beach Boulevard widening project between Hodges Boulevard and San Pablo Road

No lane closings are scheduled for next week, but brief traffic stoppages may occur at the intersections of Discovery Way and San Pablo Road. This project should be finished in the summer of 2011.

J. Turner Butler Boulevard widening between Kernan Boulevard and San Pablo Road

Single lanes will be closed in both directions from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. daily from Monday, November 2 through Friday, November 6. The project should be finished by late November.

J. Turner Butler Boulevard eastbound exit to Gate Parkway

One lane on the exit ramp will be closed on Tuesday, November 3 from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. for routine sign maintenance.

S.R. 9A/Heckscher Drive interchange improvement project

Lane closings may occur at various locations within the project limits next week on S.R. 9A, Heckscher Drive and New Berlin Road. Lane closings are allowed between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. New Berlin Road at the railroad crossing near S.R. 9A is closed until this fall. This project should be completed in November.

S.R. 9A between the Dames Point Bridge and Mill Cove

Various lanes in both directions will be closed on Thursday, November 5 from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Various southbound lanes will be closed nightly on Monday, November 2 and Tuesday, November 3 from 8:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. Routine bridge maintenance will be occurring.

S.R. 9A resurfacing between North Main Street and New Berlin Road

Single lanes in both directions and various ramps within the project limits will be closed nightly next week from Sunday, November 1 through Friday, November 6. Lane closings will occur between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m., and ramp closing times are between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. This project will be finished in the summer of 2010.

S.R. A1A resurfacing project between 9th Avenue North and the Duval/St. Johns county line

Single lanes may be closed in both directions at various locations within the project limits from Monday, November 2 through Thursday, November 5 between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. This project should be finished by the end of the year.

S.R. A1A resurfacing project from Mayport Road to the ferry landing area

Single lanes will be closed nightly from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. from Sunday, November 1 through Thursday, November 5. The project should be completed this fall.

Atlantic Boulevard/A1A resurfacing and improvements from Mayport Road to 9th Avenue North

Single lanes at various locations within the project limits will be closed from Monday, November 2 through Friday, November 6 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. This project will be finished in the summer of 2010.

Atlantic Boulevard resurfacing project between Kings Avenue and University Boulevard

Single lanes in both directions near Bartram Road will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. from Monday, November 2 through Friday, November 6. This project should be finished in the spring 2010.

San Juan Avenue (S.R. 128) over Cedar Creek

Single westbound lanes will be closed daily from Monday, November 2 through Wednesday, November 4 between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. for roadway maintenance activities.

Blanding Boulevard resurfacing from the Duval County line and Kingsley Avenue (Clay County)

Single lanes will be closed in both directions from Sunday, November 1 through Saturday, November 7 between 9:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. nightly. The southernmost median opening next to the Orange Park Mall near Wells Road is closed until approximately the first week in November for construction activities. The project should finish this fall.

U.S. 17/Doctors Inlet Bridge widening between Milwaukee Avenue and Creighton Road (Clay County)

Single southbound lane closings are scheduled to be closed from Sunday, November 1 through Saturday, November 7 from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. and single northbound lanes will be closed during the same dates from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. The projected completion time for this project is the winter of 2010.

U.S. 17 resurfacing between C.R. 220 and Creighton Road (Clay County)

Night lane closings are scheduled from Sunday, November 1 through Saturday, November 7. Northbound lane closings will occur from 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., and southbound lane closings will occur from 8 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. This project is scheduled to be finished in the winter of 2009.

Black Creek Bridge replacement project on S.R. 21 in Middleburg (Clay County)

Single lane closings in both directions may occur between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. from Monday, November 2 through Friday, November 6. This project should be finished in the spring of 2010

S.R. 21 widening project between Old Jennings Road and Knight Boxx Road (Clay County)

Lanes are scheduled to be closed next from Monday, November 2 through Friday, November 6. Northbound lane closings can occur from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., and southbound lane closings can occur from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. This project is scheduled to be finished in the spring of 2011.

Peoria Road (C.R. 224A) road widening project from College Drive to Moody Avenue (Clay County)

Daytime lane closings are scheduled for next week. The project should be finished in the late fall.

S.R. 23 resurfacing project between Old Jennings Road and Kindewood Drive (Clay County)

Single lanes may be closed on various nights next week (Monday through Friday) between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. Two-way traffic will be maintained without detours. This project should be finished in early 2010.

I-95 interchange modification at C.R. 210 (St. Johns County)

Southbound lane closings on I-95 will occur next week (Monday through Thursday) between 5:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. This project will be finished in the spring of 2010.

C.R. 2 between C.R. 121 and the Florida/Georgia state line (Nassau County)

Daytime lane closings will occur for a widening and resurfacing project. This project should be finished by the end of this year.
