Dear Council President Yarborough,

In accordance with the request of the Finance Committee, the Public Service Grant Council ("PSGC") met and reviewed the 3rd quarter's public service grant recipient's programmatic accomplishments. This report is a summary of the accomplishments from October 1, 2013 to June 31, 2014 from the 31 contracted PSG programs across all four Priority Populations. **PSG dollars are used to leverage other services and funds; however, these numbers represent the actual services provided with PSG funds only.**

Homeless Persons & Families- \$723,816 provided:

- 329 individuals with permanent housing
- 136 individuals obtained employment
- 103,798 meals & 496,048 pounds of food
- 5,492 homeless intake assessments
- 273,612 nights of emergency shelter to 936 homeless individuals

Low-Income Persons & Families \$488,063 provided:

- 47 Household prevent from being homeless/ evicted
- 47 individuals gained employment
- 111 individuals with training/assistance leading to employment
- 6293 medical follow-up appointments
- 50 hearing aids from the 882 hearing evaluations
- 1895 Case Management hours
- 16,035 bags of food & 40,644 pounds of food
- 82,533 calls for assistance with 67,541 referrals for financial assistance
- 239 Safety Planning Assessments resulting in Zero Homicides
- 42 individuals received substance abuse treatment

Low-Income Homebound Seniors \$17,522 provided:

• 2,614 home delivered meals to seniors

Adults with Physical, Behavioral, and Mental Disabilities \$269,140 provided:

- 66 individuals with skills to gained employment
- 55 disabled individuals literacy training toward employment
- 547 Mental Health Screenings

Totaling \$1,498,541
