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## A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the City of Jacksonville, Duval County; amending chapter 2014-70, Laws of Florida, as amended; providing exemption from Section 327.37(6), Florida Statutes, (Water skis, parasails, aquaplanes, kite boarding, kite surfing, and moored ballooning regulated) for boarding or kite surfing within Huquenot Memorial Park in the City of Jacksonville; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Chapter 2014-70, Laws of Florida is amended to read:

- Water skis, parasails, aquaplanes, kite boarding, kite 327.37 surfing, and moored ballooning regulated .-
- (6) A person may not engage in kite boarding or kite surfing within an area that extends 1 mile in a direct line along the centerline of an airport runway and that has a width measuring one-half mile unless permitted under federal law; provided however, this subparagraph shall not apply to kite boarding or kite surfing activities occurring within Huguenot Memorial Park in the City of Jacksonville.
- Section 2. The legal description for Huguenot Memorial Park, located at 10980 Heckscher Drive, Jacksonville, Florida 32226 is as follows:
  - Those accreted lands lying within Section 20 and unsurveyed Section 17, Township 1 South, Range 29 East, Duval County,

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Florida, southeasterly of Fort George Inlet, and northerly of and adjacent to the northerly line of those lands described in Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund Deed No. 18,471 as recorded in Deed Book 817, Page 308, Public Records of Duval County, Florida, said northerly line being described as follows:

Commence at the Northwest corner of said Section 20, thence South 0°47'31" East along the westerly line of said Section 20 a distance of 2396.6 feet; thence North 89°12'29" East a distance of 2,439 feet to a point on the axis of the North Jetty, said point being the Point of Beginning of those lands described in Deed Book 817, Page 308; thence North 17°20'09" East along the westerly line of said lands a distance of 500.00 feet to the Northwest corner of said lands and the POINT OF BEGINNING of said northerly line; thence South 72°39'51" East along said northerly line a distance of 6,450 feet to an angle point in the northerly boundary of said lands and the POINT OF TERMINATION of the herein described line.

And

That portion of Government Lots Seven (7) and Eight (8) lying Southeasterly of Hecksher Drive (State Road No. 105) and Easterly of Haulover Creek, Section 19, Township 1 South, Range 29 East, Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida, excepting therefrom that portion of said Government Lot Eight (8) deeded to the State of Florida and described as Parcel No. 21 in deed recorded in the public records of said County in Deed Book 1058, pages 113 through 117.

And

All that portion of the lands described and recorded in Eng Form 1736 by the Department of the Army Lease Agreement, Project No. DACW17-1-80-2, dated 1 June 1980. Excepting therefrom all that portion lying northerly of the north line of that 100 foot tract described and recorded in Deed Book 527, page 349 of the current public records of Duval County, Florida.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
