15	Section 1. There is created a special zone in downtown								
16	Jacksonville covering the following described areas, known as								
17	Northside West, Northside East and Southbank for the purposes of								
18	this act. The areas are described as:								
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20	The Northside West area is that part of the City of								
21	Jacksonville, Duval								
22	County, Florida described as:								
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24	Begin at the point of intersection of the West right-of-way								
25	line of Main Street, State Road No. 5, with the South right-								
26	of-way line of West Bay Street; thence, Westerly along said								
27	South right-of-way line of West Bay Street to a line being a								
28	Southerly prolongation of the West right-of-way line of								
29	Julia Street; thence Northerly along said line and said West								

right-of- way line of Julia Street to the South right-of-way 1 line of Forsyth Street; thence Westerly along said South 2 right-of-way line of Forsyth Street to the West right-of-way 3 line of Pearl Street; thence Northerly along said West 4 right-of-way line of Pearl Street to the North right-of way 5 6 line of State Street; thence Westerly and Northwesterly 7 along said North right-of-way line of State Street to the 8 Northwesterly right-of-way of Interstate 95 and State Road 9 No. 9; thence Southwesterly along said Northwesterly and Westerly right-of-way line to an intersection with a line 10 being a Westerly prolongation of the Northeasterly right-of-11 way line of that portion of Interstate 95 leading to and 12 from the Fuller Warren Bridge over the St. Johns River; 13 thence Southeasterly along said line and Northeasterly 14 right-of-way line to the center line of the St. Johns River; 15 thence Northeasterly and Easterly along said center line to 16 the West right-of-way line of the John T. Alsop (Main 17 Street) Bridge; thence Northerly along said West right-of-18 way line of the John T. Alsop (Main Street) Bridge to the 19 Point of Beginning. 20

The Northside East area is that part of the City of Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida described as:

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Begin on the west, Pearl Street extending from State on the north to Forsyth Street on the south and Julia Street from Forsyth on the north to Bay Street on the south, and Main Street beginning at Bay Street on the north and extending south to the St. Johns River. The northern boundary is State Street, beginning at Pearl Street, and extends eastward to Liberty Street at which point the boundary extends eastward along the Jacksonville Expressway to a point where the Jacksonville Expressway intersects with the Haines Street Expressway. Then north along the Haines Street Expressway to Marshall Street, and then eastward along Marshall Street to Talleyrand Avenue. North along Talleyrand Avenue to Fairway Street, and then eastward along Fairway Street to the St. Johns River. The eastern and southern boundaries are the St. Johns River, beginning at Fairway Street and extending southward to a point beyond the Hart Bridge, then westward to Main Street at a point running north to Bay Street and then west along Bay Street to Julia Street, then north along Julia Street to Forsyth Street, then extending west to Pearl Street.

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15 The Southbank area is that part of the City of Jacksonville,16 Duval County, Florida described as:

Begin at the point of intersection of the North right-of-way 18 line of Gulf Life Drive with the West right-of-way line of 19 20 South Main Street, State Road No. 5; thence westerly along 21 said North right-of-way line of Gulf Life Drive to the Northeasterly right-of-way line of that portion of 22 the Jacksonville Expressway leading to and from the Acosta 23 Bridge over the St. Johns River; thence Southeasterly along 24 said Northeasterly right-of-way line to an intersection with 25 a Northeasterly prolongation of a line lying 60 feet 26 Southeasterly from, when measured at right angles to, the 27 Southeasterly face of the Prudential Building; thence 28 29 Southwesterly along said line and a Southwesterly prolongation thereof to an intersection with the South 30 right-of-way line of Prudential Drive; then Easterly along 31

1 said South right-of-way line of Prudential Drive to an 2 intersection with a Northeasterly prolongation of the 3 Westerly edge of the Easternmost Baptist Medical Center driveway; thence Southwesterly along said line and Westerly 4 5 edge of driveway and Southwesterly prolongation thereof to 6 an intersection with the Northerly right-of-way line of 7 Interstate 95, State Road No. 9; thence Easterly along said 8 Northerly right-of-way line to a point of intersection with 9 the Southwesterly edge of the Southbound roadway of South 10 Main Street; thence Northeasterly along a line drawn 11 straight from the last described point to the Northwesterly corner of Lot 18, Block 1, Bostwick's Subdivision of Block 12 46 in South Jacksonville, as shown on plat recorded in Plat 13 14 Book 3, Page 68 of the Current Public Records of said said Northwest 15 County, corner being located in the Northeasterly right-of-way line of the Northbound approach 16 to said South Main Street from said Interstate 95; thence 17 Southeasterly and Easterly along said Northeasterly right-18 of-way line and Northerly right-of-way line of Interstate 95 19 to an intersection with the Southeasterly right-of-way line 20 21 of Vine Street; thence Northeasterly along said 22 Southeasterly right-of-way line of Vine Street to the line of 23 Northeasterly that certain alley running Southeasterly through Block 17, Reeds Fourth Subdivision of 24 South Jacksonville, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book 25 1, Page 46 of the former public records of said County; 26 thence Southeasterly along said Northeasterly alley line to 27 an intersection with the Northwesterly.right-of-way line of 28 Alamo Street; thence Northeasterly along said Northwesterly 29 right-of-way line of Alamo Street and a Northeasterly 30 prolongation thereof to an intersection with the mean high 31

1 water line of the St. Johns River; thence Northwesterly along said mean high water line to an intersection with a 2 line being a Northerly prolongation of the West face of the 3 Gulf Life Insurance Company's parking garage; 4 thence 5 Southerly along said line, said West garage face, and a 6 Southerly prolongation thereof to an intersection with the 7 North right-of-way line of Gulf Life Drive; thence Westerly 8 along said North right-of-way line to the Northerly 9 prolongation of the Easterly right-of-way line of Flagler 10 Avenue; thence Northerly along said prolongation of the Easterly right-of- way line of Flagler Avenue to 11 an 12 intersection with a line being the Easterly prolongation of 13 the South face of the multistory Hilton Hotel building; 14 thence Westerly along said line, the said South face of the 15 Hilton Hotel to the Westerly right-of-way line of South Main 16 Street; thence Southerly along said Westerly right-of-way 17 line of South Main Street to the Point of Beginning. 18

- The area bound by Margaret Street to the west, Dellwood Avenue and Interstate 95 to the north and northeast, and the St. Johns River to the east and south.
- 24The East Avondale Transition Area is that part of the City25of\_Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida described as:

26The West 52.84 feet of Lot 3 of Diterichs Replat of Lot 1,27Block 8 Edgewood in Section 57, Township 2 South, Range 2628East as recorded in Plat Book 2 at Page 86, Public Records29of Duval County, Florida, together with all improvements

thereon.

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The West Avondale Transition Area is that part of the City of Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida described as:

Lots One(1), Two (2), three (3) and Four (4) of B.J. Skinner's Subdivision, of Block Three (3) of Diterich's Subdivision of part of the Hutchinson Grant, according to Plat recorded in Plat Book 8, Page 14, of the current public records of Duval County, Florida.

Section 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 561.20(1), 11 Florida Statutes, in the areas herein described as Northside 12 West, Northside East, and Southbank, and Urban Transition, 13 East Avondale Transition Area, and West Avondale Transition 14 15 Area, the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the Department of Business Regulation may issue a special 16 17 alcoholic beverage license to any bona fide restaurant containing all necessary equipment and supplies for and 18 19 serving full course meals regularly and having accommodations at all times for service of 100 or more 20 patrons at tables and occupying not less than 1,800 square 21 feet of floor space which derive no less than 51 percent of 22 gross income per annum from the sale of food consumed on the 23 24 premises; provided that such licenses shall be subject to 25 local zoning requirements setting distance requirements 26 between liquor serving establishments and churches and schools and to any provision of the alcoholic beverage laws 27 of the state and rules of the division not inconsistent 28 herewith. 29
