The minutes from the October 23, 2012 were discussed but not approved due to a lack of a quorum.

Ms. Miller provided an update on the status of the online lobbyist registration. Mr. Jacquot suggested that the subcommittee offer a demo to the ethics Commission and lobbyists at a future meeting, once completed.

The members discussed the text message policies and the retention of messages. The chair reported that the city has selected a vendor for phone services and the most senior management have dropped the city owned devices in favor of their personal devices.

Mr. Gabriel stated that employees are trained and the any public business conducted on personal devices has to be retained.


Ms. Miller provided an update on the proposed ordinance relating to permitting the public to speak at public noticed meetings. A copy of Debra Braga's email in response to the proposed legislation was distributed.

Ms. Miller and Mr. Gabriel will work on additional details regarding the proposed legislation, making it and Ethics Commission deny public comments.
