RESOLUTION OF THE JACKSONVILLE ETHICS COMMISSION

April 17, 2017

The Jacksonville, Florida Ethics Commission is a local forum established by the Jacksonville City Charter to consider ethics issues.

The Jacksonville Ethics Commission supports the independence of the Florida Ethics Commission ratified by Florida citizens and mandated in Article 2, Section 8(f) of the Florida Constitution. The Jacksonville Ethics Commission further recognizes that the “Delegation of Authority” memorandum issued by the Senate President and House Speaker on March 21, 2017, creates serious conflicts of interest, especially when individual legislators attempt to exercise administrative oversight over employees of the Florida Ethics Commission. Additionally, the memorandum violates the constitutionally mandated independence of the Florida Ethics Commission and is not in the best interests of Florida citizens.
