March 2018 Updates As A Reminder

Since the inception of the JSEB program one of our main goals was to provide certified vendors with meaningful and productive educational and training opportunities.

One of the major changes is the redesign of our training programs. We have been working with Florida State College at Jacksonville, the Small Business Development Center at UNF, Edwards Waters College and the Northeast Florida Safety Council and other entities to provide you with meaningful education and training opportunities.

As a result of these changes beginning October 1st there will be a new process for meeting your continuing education requirements for renewal of your JSEB certification. We will work with those companies who renew for the remaining months of 2017 by accepting any points you have earned for renewal. Beginning in January of 2018 all renewing JSEB vendors will be required to attend one of the free business skills continuing education opportunities provided by the JSEB office. This two night course must be attended by the qualifying owner. If qualifying owner does not attend it will not be counted toward your renewal requirement. Please bring photo id to sign in. In addition anyone arriving more than 15 minutes late to either the 1st or 2nd night of the reguired course will not receive credit for attending and will have to take another course.

The technical courses such as OSHA and First Aid and CPR can be attended by the owner and verified employees of the company.

As of January 1, 2018 only JSEB provided business education training courses will be accepted for renewal of your JSEB certification.
