**MONTHLY REPORTS**

**Noise Complaints**

Blane Johnson, Environmental Program Supervisor reported the following:

- 28 noise complaints were received
- 0 NTC's were issued
- 1 complaint was referred to the Jacksonville Sherriff's Office (JSO)
- 0 investigations were referred to enforcement

**Air & Odor Complaints**

Blane Johnson reported the following:

- 10 odor complaints were received, 0 validated
- 0 were referred to Enforcement
- 0 nuisance complaints were received, 0 validated
- 6 Air Pollution complaint were received, 0 validated

- 30 Open Burring complaints were received, 2 validated
- 0 referred to enforcement
- 100% of all odor complaints were investigated within 4 hours
- 92% of all air pollution complaints were investigated within 24 hours

### **EPB ADMINISTRATOR REPORT**

Melissa Long, EQD Chief, and Tree Kilbourn, EQD Enforcement, discussed information gathered during their review of the penalty matrix used for air related issues. The penalty structure had not been reviewed for a number of years. Based on discussion at the March EPB meeting, particular review was completed of historical information and structure for VOCs and Particulate Matter infractions. Discussion followed which allowed for EPB members to understand the changes being made. They thanked the staff for work done.

It was shared that unintended consequences might arise from recent changes in the dumpster penalty structure. Moving forward, multiple infractions observed during one period will be bundled into one.
