Call to Order

Chair Bobby Baker called the meeting to order at 4:35 pm.

Groundwater Resources

Amando David., gave the groundwater report (documents attached).

Departmental Report

Terry Carr shared the following:

- Complaint Response - 117 CARE issues were received, 128 were closed, 2 canceled, 30 open issues
- Collection System Permits - 3 collection system permits were received, 4 permits were processed
- John Flowe made a presentation to the Blight Team concerning 24 Car Wash Facilities
 - 20 had no runoff, 4 car wash facilities had discharges to the cities stormwater system. Notice to Correct (NTCs) were issued, the discharges ceased and corrective actions were taken.
 - Staff revisited the car wash facilities and 4 facilities were closed. 7 car wash facilities were referred to DEP for best management practices (no labels on containers)

- BMAP I Community Cleanup - EQD captained two St Johns River sites at the March 19th KJB St Johns River Cleanup Celebration. 15,000 pounds of trash were removed (a very productive effort). The next cleanup is scheduled for September 17th.
- A walk of Miller Creek is scheduled for July 30th.
- Water quality sampling will be done to conduct a study of Miller Creek
- Training for city staff, private contractors, federal and state agencies dealing with stormwater issues is forthcoming.
- Shell Fish Study – The Final Report will be submitted by May 31st
- A revised monitoring plan for the city's NPDES permit for the stormwater system has been submitted. Additional monitoring will be conducted at Miller Creek, Red Bay Branch and Strawberry Creek

EPB Administrator Report

James Richardson shared the following:

- A new parking policy for Boards and Commissions memo has been emailed to the EPB. Please review the new changes.
- Earth Day T-Shirts are available for purchase. Earth Day Event at the Jacksonville Landing is scheduled for Saturday, April 23, 2016.
