**CALL TO ORDER**

Chair Tony Bellamy, P.E. called the meeting to order at 4: 35 p.m.

**MONTHLY COMPLAINTS**

**Air and Odor Complaints (June)**

Steve Pace, P.E., Environmental Engineering Manager Senior, reported the following:

- 6 nuisance complaints were received and investigated of which 0 complaint(s) were validated
- 28 odor complaints were received and investigated of which 7 complaints were validated
- 0 open burning permits were issued
- 4 open burning complaints were received and investigated

**Noise Complaints (June)**

Mr. Pace reported the following:

- 22 noise complaints were received
- 19 warning letters were issued
- 6 complaints were referred to the Jacksonville Sherriff's Office (JSO)

Mr. Pace shared that there have been ongoing complaints regarding loud music at Endo Exo. The Consent Order with Compliance Plan / SEP approved by the Board allows the nighttime noise level not to exceed 65 dBA during construction of their two phase project to reduce the noise. No violations have been noted. Phase I completion date is August 30, 2013.

## **ENFORCEMENT**

### **Board Cases**

Dana Brown, Environmental Enforcement Administrator, asked that the following order be presented to the Board for approval under Consent Order settlements:

- **RPD Management, LLC d/b/a Intuition Ale Works (NP-12-06)** - Causing, allowing or permitting emission of sound in exceedance of daytime noise standards - settlement \$3,599.

Add on item

- **Exact, Inc. (AP-13-04)** - Application of noncompliant coatings to metal parts; failure to maintain daily records of coatings used – settlement \$3,040.

Chair Bellamy entertained a motion to forward the consent orders to the Steering Committee, which was properly seconded and approved.

## **DEPARTMENTAL REMARKS**

Board Member Michelle Tappouni shared the remarks presented to the Water Committee Meeting by Scott Trebatoski, Acting Chief. Mr. Trebatoski met with Greg Strong and section heads of FDEP Divisions to discuss the Title V Program budget cuts. There is a possibility that FDEP will restore a portion of the Title V funding.

The overall proposed impact to the Neighborhoods Department in the COJ FY13-14 budget is the loss of three positions in EQD.

## **OLD/NEW BUSINESS**

- **Open Variances**  
Daniel Hlaig, JEA, provided an update on several variances held by JEA and stated that no noise complaints have been received to date. Nighttime work will begin on the Riverside Project Wednesday, July 17, 2013.
- **Health Zone 1 Study**  
Postponed.
- **Metro Park Noise**  
Staff has completed the noise sound level reports requested by the Ad-hoc Metro Park Noise Committee. Revisions to Chapter 368, Ordinance will soon be proposed to address the Metro Park noise issue.
