## PUBLIC NOTICE OCTOBER 31, 2023 DRAFT CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EVALUATION REPORT (CAPER)

The Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) provides accomplishments and expenditure information on the four HUD programs (CDBG, HOME, HOPWA and ESG) administered by the City of Jacksonville during the 2022 program year (PY2022) which ran from October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023.
