1. **Call to Order/Verify Quorum:** Chair Larry Solomon called the meeting to order at 6:08 pm; it was established that a quorum was present and everyone was welcomed.
2. **Approval of the Previous Meeting Summary:** April minutes were approved. All were in agreement.
3. **Presentation:**
 - Milton Locklear (North Florida Transportation Planning Organization) - Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Fiscal Years 2016/2017 through 2020/2021
4. **Elected Officials' Reports** None
5. **Staff Reports:**
 - Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO) – Lt. Powers, crime has been steady over the past 30 days, the Sheriff's Office has pre-approved overtime for Officers; when calling in a report please give your best description.
 - Jacksonville Fire & Rescue (JFRD) – Lt. Westberry, with the summer coming up be aware of brush fires and kids swimming in pools, retention ponds, beaches and lakes.
 - Duval County School Board – Deidra Johnson, June 10th is the last day of school; the following schools will be converting, John Love, S.P. Livingston, Susie Tolbert and Long Branch. Student Choice application deadline has been extended until June 1st, you can call 390-2000 for more information.
 - Neighborhoods - Municipal Code Compliance – Danny Connell, two personnel are out because of a car accident; nine properties were cited on Knight Drive, two addresses were cited on Van Gundy Road and a pool on Ribault Scenic Drive that did not have a fence around it was cited.
 - Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) – Jim Green was part of the presentation.
 - Parks, Recreation and Community Services – Robert Hall, Summer Night Lights will be in some communities Thursday – Saturday 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. The Emmitt Reed and Kennedy Center Pools will not be open until July for repairs. The steps on the sliding board are scheduled to be repaired at Ray Greene Park. Summer Camp registration is now open.
 - JTA - Cheryl Riddick: The JTA Board approved the design for the new Jacksonville Regional Transportation Center; the Soutel Transit Hub will be completed in July; the downtown skyway will have special hours during the Jazz Festival (Friday 9 a.m. - midnight, Saturday 11 am – midnight and Sunday 11 a.m. to 11p.m.).
6. **Subcommittee/Liaison Reports :**
 - LUZ (Land Use and Zoning)/ Governmental Affairs – Roxsan Currier, Ordinance # 2016-0329, an 8 acre dump on Pickettville Road was brought before the subcommittee and the subcommittee voted against the project.
 - Membership - Larry Solomon, nothing to report.
 - Taxation Revenue & Utilization of Expenditures (TRUE) – John Pittman, the T.R.U.E. Commission is currently a few members short. The board has asked the Office of General Counsel to confirm if it is unconstitutional according to the Florida Constitution to accept incentives from private businesses to come to Jacksonville.
7. **Neighborhood Coordinator's Report** – Stacey Burch: the CPAC summary will have a new look starting in May; Eastside Coalition Community along with Groundworks Jacksonville will host a community event on the Saturdays before every Jacksonville Jaguars home game starting in September.
8. **Chair's Report** – Larry Solomon, nothing to report.
9. **Unfinished Business** – The Chair will follow-up on getting a class on how to become a 501(c)3.

11. **Public Comments/Concerns/Announcements**
 - Tim Rossetter was told he did not have to pay for his sidewalk to be repaired in front of his house.
 - JSO is having difficulty copying footage from home security cameras because of the difference in software.
 - Duval Country School Principals can request sidewalk repairs that are around their school campus.
 - Municipal Code cannot do anything about neighbors storing their trash cans in front of or on the side of the house.
 - Raines had 24,740 people and Ribault had 5,993 people last year at the pools.
 - If your neighborhood park is in partnership with the City of Jacksonville and you feel your community is not informed about the events in the community please contact Parks and Recreation.
 - Morris Manor Senior Living is looking for an exercise instructor for the seniors.
 - The Jacksonville Public Library and the Friends of the Dallas Graham Library agreed to meet and discuss the future plans of the library. An announcement will be made on the next meeting.
 - Positive Riverside Optimal Urban Development (P.R.O.U.D.) thanked the CPAC for supporting them with the LUZ/PUD and Planning Commission in the Riverside Area.
