## **RESOLUTION JIA/CRA-2019-03**

A RESOLUTION OF THE **JACKSONVILLE** INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY ("BOARD") ADOPTING A FY 2019-2020 PROPOSED BUDGET; ALLOWING FOR THE SOLICITATION OF COMPETITIVE PROPOSALS AND AWARD OF CONTRACTS THROUGH CHAPTER 126, ORDINANCE CODE, APPROVED AS PART OF THIS BUDGET; **AUTHORIZING** THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ALL CONTRACTS; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2019, the Jacksonville International Airport Advisory Board approved the FY 2019-2020 Proposed Budget with a unanimous vote of 4-0 recommending consideration by the Agency Board.

WHEREAS, the Board is empowered to authorize projects within the JIA CRA and finds that the following Mobility Corridor Projects comply with, and further the purposes and objectives of the JIA CRA Redevelopment Plan.

- Duval Road-Airport to Biscayne-Roadway Resurfacing-Mobility "cc",
- Duval Road-Airport to Biscayne-Sidewalks-Mobility "cc" (partially funded in the FY2018-2019 Amended Budget), and
- Ranch Road-Duval to Tradeport-Sidewalks-Mobility "dd".
- 1. Page 4: JIA CRA Redevelopment Plan
  - h) Provide pedestrian linkages within the project area;
  - k) Provide public improvements to complement and service new development, including needed utilities also including: electric, water, sewer and gas line extensions, street closings and changes, streetscape improvements, open space landscaping, pedestrian linkages and parking.

2. Page 7: JIA CRA Redevelopment Plan

Goal 4: Establish Non-Motorized Transportation Network – The establishment

and use of an interconnected system of right-of-way, which provides for the safe

movement of pedestrians and bicyclists throughout the City, shall be supported.

Goal 7: Transportation System Safety - The traffic circulation system shall be

operated in a manner which values the safety of its citizens as being of equal

importance to efficiency and expedience of design and materials.

**BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board:

Section 1. The FY 2019-2020 Proposed Budget attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is

hereby adopted by the Board.

Section 2. The Office of Economic Development ("OED"), as staff for the JIA/CRA,

in conjunction with the Department of Public Works, is hereby authorized to develop a

Request for Proposals for the Mobility Projects, and to coordinate with the Office of

Procurement for awarding a contract in accordance with Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, for the

following capital improvement projects that were approved as part of this fiscal year

2019/2020 budget: Duval Road-Airport to Biscayne-Roadway Resurfacing-Mobility "cc",

Duval Road-Airport to Biscayne-Sidewalks-Mobility "cc", and Ranch Road-Duval to

Tradeport-Sidewalks-Mobility "dd".

Section 3. The Board requests that the Mayor direct the Department of Public Works,

in conjunction with OED, oversee the selection of the successful bidders and the contracts

awarded.

**Section 4.** This Resolution shall become effective upon a majority vote of the Board

and upon execution of the Chair.
