Earned by completing the achievement standards and applying for the award by June 1st. Clover Dollars can then be used between June 1st and May 31st of the following year. Clover Dollars can be used as scholarship for the following activities:

- Duval County 4-H Camp
- Duval County 4-H Day Camps
- State 4-H Camps
- State 4-H Activities
- District 4-H Activities
- National 4-H Activities

Clover Dollars do not carry over from year to year and cannot be applied to activities that occur after May 31st of the following year.
