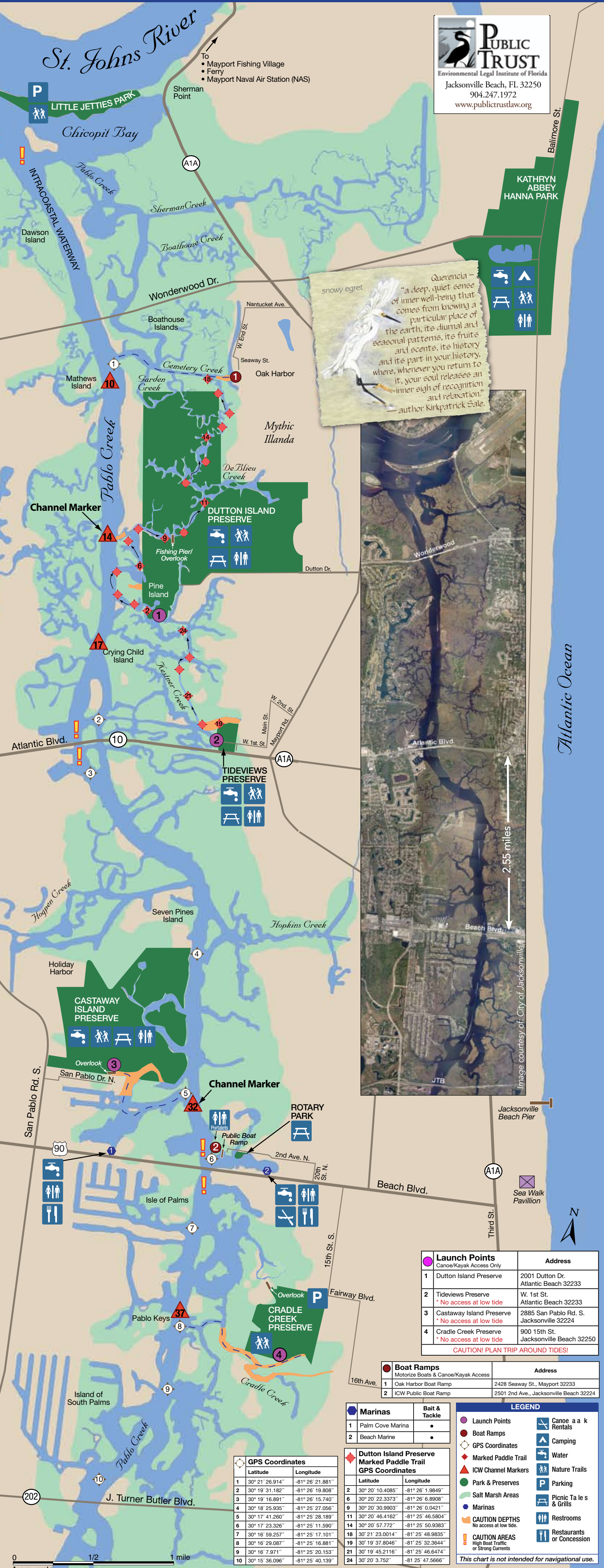


JACKSONVILLE INTRACOASTAL SALT MARSH PADDLING GUIDE
