- Mike Goldman, FDOT presented the future FDOT roadway development projects in the SE district in regard to the expansion of J. Turner Butler Blvd, 9A, the development of 9B, proposed future entrance/exit ramps off I-95, the widening project of Philips Highway and improvements at the interchange of 95 and 295.
