Call to Order/Quorum:

Introductions/Acknowledgements:

Chairman Martin welcomed everyone to the meeting and thanked them for being present. He introduced a guest speaker, Dick Berry.

- Presentation: Dick Berry, Vice Chair of North CPAC, announced that legislation is pending regarding Air Installation Compatibility Use Zones (AICUZ) for military and civilian airports in Duval County. Mr. Berry reported that each property owner within the AICUZ zones will be required to sign a notice of acknowledgement regarding noise levels, possible effects of noise on structures within the zones, and how future owners will be notified. According to Mr. Berry, future land sales, use and development will be affected. Existing structures within the zones will be affected. The next City Council meeting scheduled to address this issue is Jan. 9, 2007. Mr. Berry suggested a town meeting be held in every district with notices mailed to property owners in the zones.
