MEETING SUMMARY

Sept. 12, 2007, continued

- 1.Chair Bill Baker announced the funeral of Jessie Sammons and asked the group to observe a moment of silence. The chair called to order and verified quorum. Organizations represented: 22 of 40 = 55%
- 2.Presentation: The scheduled presenter, Sean Kelly, was unable to attend. Chair Baker asked Richard Berry to explain the Industrial Sanctuary & Areas of Situational Compatibility Overlay Zones. Bills 2007-398 established an advisory committee and defined how it works – to view every item in the area and make recommendations to the Planning and Development Department and Council. Bill 2007 – 560 identifies the overlay zones. A map was displayed.

Previous meeting **summary approved** – Roland Biederer made the motion; a second was made by Mike Gretchell. All were in favor. None opposed.

CPAC Chair Bill Baker announced the CPAC Chairs asked the Finance Committee for three coordinator positions instead of the two positions that were funded and received approval for a third position. Three coordinators will represent all six CPACs. He introduced Mary Beth Ridderman, coordinator for the North CPAC.
