This cause came on to be heard at the time and place aforesaid, when and where the following proceedings were reported by:

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PROCEEDINGS 1 2 October 1, 2015 1:30 p.m. 3 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: It's 1:30. Calling 4 the meeting to order. It's public comment. 5 don't see any on there. Do we have any? 6 (No public comment.) 7 MR. SCHMITT: All right. We'll close 8 the public comment section. 9 And my main objective today is try to 10 get settled on an hourly rate for your 11 consulting services. The Board has given me the authority to discuss with you that hourly rate. 12 13 What I'm going to do, assuming that 14 we're able to come to an agreement today, it 15 will be a temporary agreement until the Board 16 meets on the 9th. I'll attend that meeting, so 17 we'll have a quorum there and we can take it up 18 at that time and ratify it. 19 MR. KEANE: Okay. 20 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: So between now and 2.1 then it's more of a temporary agreement, pending 22 ratification by the Board, a majority of the 23 board. 24 MR. KEANE: Okay.

CHAIRMAN SCHMITT:

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The range obviously

- 1 is pretty widespread on consulting services.
- 2 I'm going to rely on you to give me some
- 3 | feedback on what you think that range should be.
- 4 | I hope you take into consideration more than
- 5 | just your market rate because I really don't
- 6 | want to have to pay you what you're worth.
- 7 You're worth way too much than what, really, I
- 8 want to pay.
- 9 So in that range -- I'm going to start
- 10 | really low. Would you be willing to do it for a
- 11 | dollar an hour?
- 12 MR. KEANE: I would not be willing to
- 13 do that. No, sir.
- 14 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: All right. How
- 15 about fifty?
- MR. KEANE: No, sir.
- 17 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: What is the upper
- 18 | end for you?
- 19 MR. KEANE: Well, my salary right now
- 20 | is about \$135 an hour after many -- you know, 25
- 21 | years here.
- 22 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: Yes.
- 23 MR. KEANE: In addition to that,
- 24 | there's the employee benefit piece that is added
- 25 on there. And I think the city usually figures

- 1 about 30 percent for pension and health and
- 2 | holidays and vacation and workers' comp and all
- 3 that. And that gives you a general idea
- 4 | about it.
- 5 MR. DURDEN: I actually don't know. I
- 6 | wouldn't be surprised that that's accurate.
- 7 MR. KEANE: I think that is a rule of
- 8 thumb, is about 30 percent.
- 9 MR. DURDEN: It wouldn't be fair for me
- 10 to answer. I actually don't know, but I
- 11 | wouldn't be surprised.
- 12 MR. KEANE: Well, I wouldn't want to
- 13 | entertain an offer for less than my current
- 14 | hourly rate that I could just forego the
- 15 employee benefit piece. So that's about a 30
- 16 percent reduction from my current hourly rate.
- 17 | But I wouldn't be interested in much less than
- 18 | that, and those funds are budgeted.
- 19 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: Yes. But there are
- 20 | other factors involved. I know what your market
- 21 rate is. It's much more than what we're
- 22 talking, even beyond the range of what you just
- 23 described. But with the other factors included,
- 24 what about 125?
- MR. KEANE: How about -- did I tell you

a minute ago, 140? Is that what I said? 1 2 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: 135. 3 MR. KEANE: 135, and you want 125? 4 Might as well go ahead and meet in the middle at 5 130. How about that? CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: Sounds fair. 6 7 that will be an hourly rate, 40-hour per week 8 cap. And the rest of it we'll have the city 9 draw up a contract, and we'll send it to you and 10 see if you agree with those terms. 11 MR. KEANE: The city or general 12 counsel? 13 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: Well, I'll get a 14 draft from them, and they'll let the city take a 15 look at it. And if you agree to it, great. If 16 not, then we'll discuss any changes that you 17 want to make. 18 MR. KEANE: Okay. 19 MR. SCHMITT: And we'll go before the majority board for a vote. Like I said, I'll 20 2.1 attend the meeting on the 9th, and we will 22 hopefully have it all worked out by then, and 23 the majority can ratify it. 24 In the meantime, we'll work off this as

being a temporary agreement with the idea that

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- 1 it will be ratified. If it's not, obviously
- 2 then anywhere between now and then is
- 3 | potentially unpaid. But I fully expect that a
- 4 | majority of the Board would ratify it.
- 5 MR. DURDEN: If I might, this would be
- 6 the equivalent of the 260,000 a year then?
- 7 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: At 130 an hour,
- 8 correct.
- 9 MR. DURDEN: At 130. Okay.
- 10 MR. KEANE: I understand.
- 11 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: Okay. Anything
- 12 else?
- MR. KEANE: So the meeting that was
- 14 | scheduled for the 9th that was billed as a
- 15 personnel committee, you want relabeled as a
- 16 | special board meeting?
- 17 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: Yes. We will add
- 18 | this to the agenda.
- 19 MS. MANNING: On the special -- on the
- 20 9th?
- MR. KEANE: And that's 9:00 o'clock, on
- 22 | the 9th?
- CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: I believe it is 9:00
- 24 o'clock.
- MS. MANNING: I believe so.

I had sent an email to Herbert that 1 2 that is technically a holiday for the office, 3 but we're fine. I will be here, and we'll have 4 the court reporter here. 5 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: Yes. We really shouldn't need the rest of the staff. I mean, 6 7 if that's their holiday, I see no reason why 8 they just couldn't take off the holiday. 9 MS. MANNING: Yes. I'll be here, and 10 we'll have to have somebody at the front desk 11 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: And I do have it for 9:00 o'clock, on October 9th. 12 13 MR. KEANE: And you have that down on 14 your schedule? 15 COURT REPORTER: Yes. 16 MR. KEANE: And the court reporter's 17 going to be here. CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: Mr. Durden, do you 18 19 have anything else? 20 MR. DURDEN: No, sir. 2.1 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: All right. 22 concludes the meeting. 23 MR. KEANE: Tell us what time it is. 24 CHAIRMAN SCHMITT: It is 1:37. 25 (Meeting adjourned at 1:37 p.m.)
