- Nominee has made an impact in the community and/or for seniors during the 2022 for the male and female of the year.
- Lifetime nominee has exemplified good work in the community and/or for seniors throughout their lifetime.
- Nominees must not work as a full-time paid employees of an organization whose primary purpose is to serve the elderly.

CRITERIA

- · The nomination must reflect the actual accomplishments(s) achieved during the past 2022 year for male and female of the year.
- · The nomination must reflect the actual accomplishments(s) achieved throughout their lifetime for the Lifetime Achievement recipient.
- · Current members of the Jacksonville-Duval County on Elder Affairs are not eliaible.

- Complete the nomination form online or on the reverse side of this sheet. Attach a supporting statement of no more than 500 words describing the nominee's activities and achievement(s). You may also include appropriate support materials. **Do Not** submit video tapes, displays, films, or scrapbooks.
