Nature Centers

Nature center hours may vary due to staff availability or special events. If visiting these parks just for the nature centers, you are encouraged to call ahead.

- <u>Tillie K Fowler Regional Park</u> Nature Center Hours: 1-4 PM, Fridays-Sundays (904) 255-6879. 7000 Roosevelt Blvd. Turn off Roosevelt Blvd onto Norman Street (across from NAS Jax entrance) and follow the road until it ends at a loop. Nature center is across from the bathrooms. Additional amenities: Park has an outdoor classroom for use with nature center, a dog park, hiking and biking trails, and a pavilion available for rental. Rentals can be made online at JaxParks.com
- Kathryn Abbey Hanna Park (904) 255- 6767. 500 Wonderwood Drive. Wonderwood drive leads to the park entrance. Nature center is located in the campground; please visit the park office to gain access to the campground during nature center hours. An entrance fee is required to enter the park.

 Additional amenities: Park has 1.5 miles of beach, a 60-acre lake, over 20 miles of hiking and biking trails, kayak and bike rentals, over 200 campsites, shelters available for rental, a children's splash park, and an event venue. Call park or go to JaxParks.com for reservations.
