# 2023 SUMMER CAMP FREQUENT ASK QUESTIONS

#### 1. Does your site offer summer camp?

Yes, Day Enrichment Camp. Campers will explore nature, play team sports, challenge their game skills and tap into their creative imagination while developing education and social skills. They will also meet guest speakers and enjoy trips to Florida Theater, Jumbo Shrimp game, Brentwood Golf Course, the Jacksonville Zoo, and Adventure Landing (Field Trips Subject to Change). Add to all that an End of Summer Bash featuring a field day of fun, games, and music; and no one will want to miss this JaxParks summer camp.

#### 2. How old must the child be to attend camp?

Ages 6 – 12 years old

# 3. When does summer camp start?

Camp Starts on June 20<sup>th</sup> and Ends on July 28<sup>th</sup> Camps are offered in three (3) two-week sessions: Session 1 June 20 – June 30, 2023, Session 2\* July 3 – July 14, 2023 and Session 3 July 17 – 28, 2023

\*Camps will be closed Monday June 19th in honor of Juneteenth and Tuesday, July 4th, in honor of Independence Day \*

#### 4. What are the hours for camp?

All sessions are 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. Monday – Friday; Extended Day is available for an additional cost.

#### 5. How much does camp cost for campers?

Base Fee: \$75 per two-week session

Activity Fee: \$20 per two-week session (NON-REFUNDABLE)

Extended Day: \$20 per two-week session (Covers 7-8 a.m. morning & 5-6 p.m. evening)

# 6. When will I be able to sign my child up for camp?

Registration begins at 12p.m. on Tuesday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> and will be available online at https://web1.vermontsystems.com/jacksonville.html

#### 7. Do I need to create an account?

Yes, Parent/Guardian will need to create a profile or use existing login if one is already available. The parent will be the customer and the child is the member.

# 8. Will Lunch and/or Snack be provided?

Yes, lunch and snacks will be provided to all campers. Parents are responsible for providing breakfast.

#### 9. Do you offer anything for teens ages 13-17?

Yes, Teen Power for ages 13 to 17. Teen power program is to train qualified youth to work in meaningful volunteer service-oriented position as a junior counselor. Each volunteer will be issued a certificate of achievement at the conclusion of the enrichment camp verifying the total number of volunteer service hours served. Space is limited and an interview selection process applies. Contact the camp director at the specific location in which you are interested. Registration will be downtown only and based upon approval. The locations are the same as Day-Enrichment Camps.

Interviews begins – April 3, 2023 – Contact the site of interest to set up an interview.
