Richard Reichard moved to recommend approval of Jeshua T. Kavanaugh's application for disability pension to the Board of Trustees, seconded by Michael Pelletier. The vote passed unanimously.

V. Executive Director's Report

Timothy Johnson informed the Advisory Committee of the 2023 PFPF Annual Meeting, which will be held at the PFPF Office on April 21 at 9AM. The Fund's Investment Consultant, Actuary, and Auditor will present their reports on the Fund's performance over the past fiscal year.

James Holderfield said the Annual Meeting is a nice opportunity to meet the Board of Trustees, and to hear the reports from the Fund's Actuary, and investment managers.

Steve Lundy discussed the Share Plan refunds to members on today's agenda, noting that the 'odd' amount of \$16.44 is due to the 'termination distribution'. The Termination Distribution is the distribution of the share plan account balances of members who terminated without the minimum 10 years of service necessary to be eligible to receive their own Share Plan distribution, to the remaining active members of the plan. The members who received the \$16.44 had already received their Share Plan account balance refund, but had not yet received the termination distribution.
