IV. Executive Director's Report

a. DROP Enrollment Statistics

Timothy Johnson said he had to meet with a Trustee this morning and was unable to attend this meeting in person. He said he had nothing to report, but Steve Lundy has a DROP enrollment presentation.

Steve Lundy presented the Analysis of DROP Enrollment Statistics. Fiscal Year 2021 just wrapped up for DROP applications. The July DROP date was the last quarterly DROP enrollment date of the Fiscal Year. FY2021 saw the highest DROP enrollments (156) since FY2011 (158), and the second highest since the very first year of DROP inception.

James Holderfield asked for an update on the Affidavit Breakfast Social.

Chuck Hayes said there was decent attendance, but lower than expected due to COVID-19 concerns among retirees.

James Holderfield asked for an update on the remaining affidavits.

Chuck Hayes said that 688 affidavits are outstanding. We will work until the end of the month, then send the second mailing, and put a reminder in the pay notice.

Steve Lundy updated the Advisory Committee on the election. Richard Reichard, Michael Shell, and Thomas Lumpkin have terms expiring on December 31, 2021. An election will be held in November. Qualification forms will be sent this month to all eligible members who may be interested in running in the election. He asked the members to fill out the qualification form if they intend to serve another four years.
