Richard Patsy asked how returns would be affected if TSW was not permitted to invest in high-yield.

Bill Bellamy said that it would not affect the investment process. The allocation to high-yield is 10%, and is considered a core return income enhancer to the portfolio.

Richard Patsy asked what sectors TSW avoids in the high-yield environment.

Bill Bellamy said that TSW avoids the energy industry, and telecom. It is hard to get paid for taking on the extra risk in these sectors.
