The City of Jacksonville, along with the Jacksonville Sister Cities Association (JSCA), will be celebrating the life of the Honorable Nelson Mandela by sponsoring a fundraiser banquet to aid in health programs for the citizens of Nelson Mandela Bay Municipality.

Jacksonville has been twinned with Nelson Mandela Bay Municipality, South Africa since 2000. This is a unique relationship because Jacksonville is the only U.S. city to have a sister cities relationship with the Municipality.

In October 2004, a JSCA outbound delegation delivered wheelchairs to 240 disabled citizens of the Municipality. From 2009 to 2013, JSCA administered a grant from the Gates Foundation to aid in the purchase of a Mobile Medical Clinic and the renovation of several elementary schools' lavatories. A portion of the ticket price will be used to purchase medicines and supplies for the Mobile Clinic and continue the humanitarian aid efforts to the region.
