Summary of Program:

19 ex-offender students participated in vocational training programs at Clara White Mission during December 2015. 47% of all offenders served during the month were categorized as violent offenders and 47% had been released from jail or prison within the last 24 months. During January, no rearrests occurred and 1 program graduate became employed. All students participated in informational session with Legal Aid.

Program Overall Status:

Successes:

No students or graduates were re-arrested. 1 graduate became employed; 9 total employed since October. 19 ex-offenders were served during the month. Students received on the job training and classroom instruction in state licensed vocational programming that will result in industry credentials for graduates of the program. Vocational skills training is supplemented with soft skills training, life skills development, GED & ABE classes, mental health counseling, and goal-directed case management.

Challenges:

Providing the vocational training, supportive services and job placement assistance to re-entering former offenders without financial support due to Jacksonville Journey's revised reimbursement schedule is significantly impacting Clara White's capacity to deliver vocational training. Exoffenders in need of services will ultimately suffer the greatest impact.
