PARK & CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

The City of Jacksonville manages Huguenot Memorial Park to provide users with a safe and enjoyable outing. Please be advised that many natural hazards and inherently dangerous activities are possible. It is your responsibility to read carefully and follow all rules, signs and directions of park staff. Violators may be required to leave immediately without refund of any payments made. Management reserves the right to incorporate additional rules as needed to protect the park and its users. The City of Jacksonville and Huguenot Memorial Park cannot be held responsible for accidents, injuries, and damages that may occur.

Huguenot Memorial Park has a no refund policy – all sales are final.

DO NOT LEAVE VALUABLES UNATTENDED. MANAGEMENT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOSS OR THEFT OF PROPERTY

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Minors under the age of 18 must have adult supervision at all times.**
- **Pets are allowed for registered campers ONLY. No day use patrons, shelter customers, or campsite visitors are allowed pets. Please see the office if you have questions regarding park day-use access with a service animal.**

- Campsites are reserved for camping only and will not be available for day use or fishing without camping in an authorized camping unit. Sites are primitive and have no water or electrical hookups. An ADA site with electricity is available and requires a doctor's note.

Swimming: **Swimming is allowed but always at your own risk.** It is your responsibility to assess the water conditions and decide if it is safe to enter. Non-swimmers and children under the age of 18 should always require adult supervision. Lifeguards on duty from Memorial Day to Labor Day are not responsible for accidents or injuries that may occur.

Re-Entry: Day use patrons, shelter customers, and campsite visitors must pay upon each entry. Re-entry is for registered campers ONLY and is available from 6:00 am to 11:00 pm. Please note entry gates are locked every night after 11:00 pm.

Shelters: must be rented/permitted prior to use and are not for free use at any time – reservations can be made by calling the office.

Dune Protection: No vehicles, foot traffic or pets permitted in the Dunes. First offense for dune encroachment will be ejection without a refund.

Wildlife Protection: It is unlawful to disturb and/or harass any wildlife in the park. Seasonal and permanent closures of areas of the park will occur. It is the responsibility of the visitor to be aware of the rules and policies of the park and to obey posted signage. If assistance is needed with wildlife, contact the office at (904) 255-4255.

Speed Limits: The speed limit on the asphalt road is 15 MPH. Speed limit in the campground and on all sand areas is 5 MPH. Performing doughnuts, power slides, rooster tails, careless driving or excessive speeds is grounds for ejection without a refund.

Fishing Licenses: Licenses are required for resident and non-resident saltwater fishing, in accordance with Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) laws.

Motorized Vehicles: All motorized vehicles must be licensed for street use in Florida. No unlicensed vehicles, golf carts, or electric/battery powered vehicles are allowed. Authorized mobility equipment for disabled persons must be properly permitted and documented.

Outside Structures: Hanging anything from trees is prohibited. Equipment, appliances, tarps, clotheslines, and portable toilets are not allowed.

Alcoholic Beverages, Glass Containers & Illegal Narcotics: All are prohibited in accordance with City of Jacksonville Ordinances and State of Florida Statutes. Violators may be ejected from the park without a refund. Park staff has the right to inspect coolers if alcohol is suspected.

Drones, Fireworks, Slingshots, Paint, Pellet, or BB Guns: are not permitted on park premises. Huguenot Park is a NO DRONE ZONE.

Management reserves the right to evict, remove, and/or ask to leave anyone for behavior detrimental to the park, campground, park patrons and its visitors; or for failing to observe the park rules as per the City of Jacksonville and Huguenot Memorial Park.

CAMPING

Registered campers are responsible for all group members and visitors at all times. FOR YOUR SECURITY AND PRIVACY – Do not give out the shower codes

Reservations: Customers must be at least 18 years of age and provide a valid driver's license to reserve a campsite. Reservations may be made in person or by telephone (9:00 am – 5:00 pm) with cash, credit or debit cards. No personal checks are accepted.

All payments are final - no refunds for any reason.

Check-In: 1:00 pm – 9:30 pm. No check-ins after 9:30 p.m.
Check-Out: 12:00 p.m. Extensions/renewals are due by 11:00 am. Reoccurring late payments may result in eviction.

Cancellations: In the event of a reservation cancellation, one night's payment including tax will be charged. There is a one-time opportunity to reschedule a reservation without a loss of payment if the office is contacted by 5 p.m. two days in advance of the reservation day. The reservation must be moved to a new available date within a three month period from the original date.

Occupancy Limitations: Maximum of six occupants per site. Campers under the age of 18 must have at least one adult 21 or older present. Minors must remain at their campsite and under adult supervision after 10:00 pm. Campsite occupancy is limited to one of the following groups or camping rigs per site:

- One motor home, two tents and two vehicles
- One trailer with pull vehicle, two tents and one additional vehicle
- Three tents and two vehicles

All items must fit on campsite. Surplus vehicles unable to fit on the campsite must park in overflow parking areas only, never on vacant sites.

Tent & RV Requirements:

- Three tent maximum per site – set up by 10:00 pm: must be of commercial manufacture and consist of flame retardant material with integral floor, ceiling and walls.
- RVs must have outside connections for water and electricity. Only self-contained RV's are permitted - No sleeping in utility trailers.

Management reserves the right to refuse a camping reservation based on non-compliance of requirements.

Parking Passes & Campsite Visitors: One parking pass is included with each campsite registration; additional passes are \$5 each. Visitors must obtain parking passes from the office and are permitted to stay until 10:00 pm and must pay with each entry into the park.

Pets: Allowed for registered campers ONLY; three pet maximum per site (fee required). All pets must be properly licensed in accordance with City Ordinance, remain under control, leashed at all times and are not allowed in buildings or along shorelines (in or out of vehicles). Pets are to be kept inside at night, quiet, and not tied to any trees. Violations may result in ejection from park without a refund.

Campfires: Permitted in fire rings only. Wood must be free of any hazardous materials such as metal - **NO PALLETS**. Please extinguish upon retiring. Removing fire rings or picnic tables from campsites is prohibited.

Trash: Please deposit trash in dumpsters located in the campground.

Quiet Hours: 10:00 pm – 7:00 am. Generators must be turned off.

Camping Limit: Tent camping - maximum 14 days within a 45 day period
RV camping - maximum 30 days within a 45 day period

RV & Car Washing and Soliciting: These activities are not permitted. Vending or selling of goods or services is not permitted.
