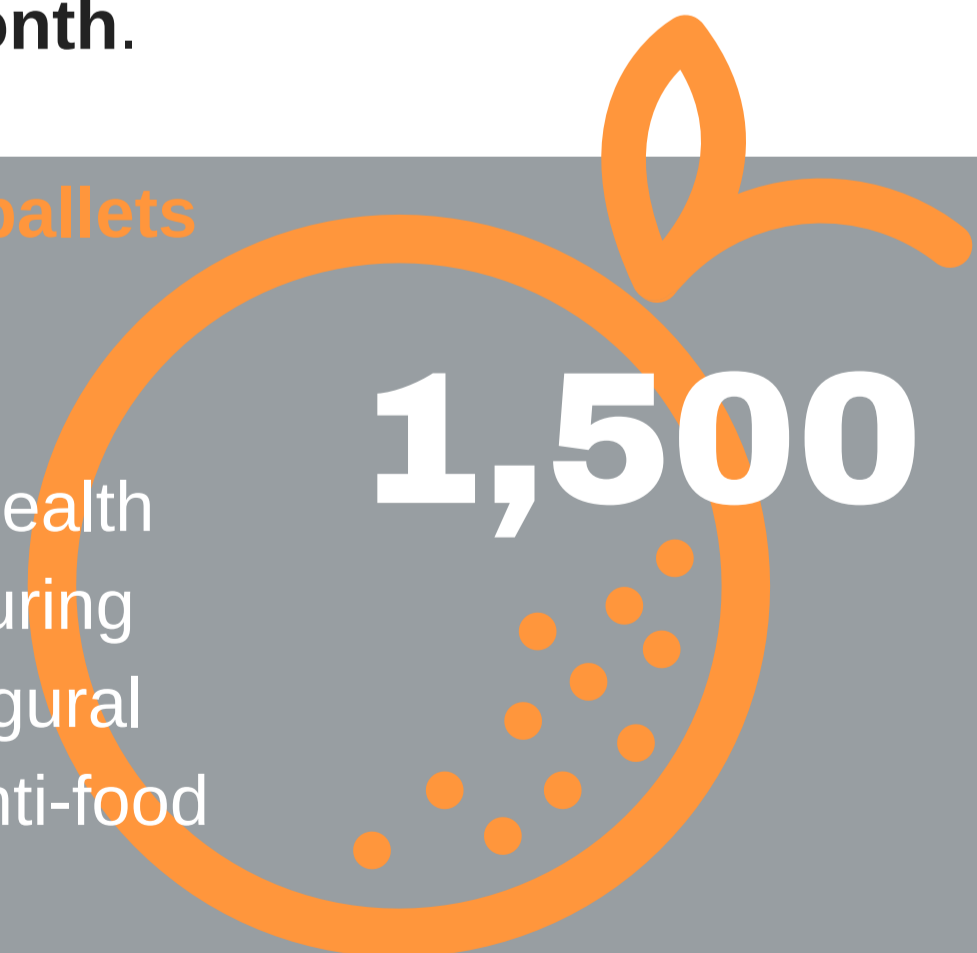


The **number of miles** Jacksonville citizens are encouraged to complete each month while walking or running throughout the city with a **Mayorthon a Month**.
