country to meet their counterparts; and

WHEREAS: Taiwan is the 11th largest trading partner of the United States, with

bilateral trade in goods and services reaching close to \$90 billion in 2017, and is the 7th largest export destination for U.S. agricultural products, creating more than 350,000 jobs in the United States; and

WHEREAS: Taiwan contributes to regional development, peace and prosperity by

participating in numerous international organizations, including the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), the World Health Organization (WHO) and the International Criminal Police Organization

(INTERPOL).
