WHEREAS:	The Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta (the Sixth Federal Reserve District) opened its Jacksonville Branch in 1918. This year marks a century of providing economic, financial and community services to our city and surrounding areas; and
WHEREAS:	The Sixth Federal Reserve District includes Alabama, Florida and Georgia, and Louisiana; and
WHEREAS:	The Federal Reserve System consists of twelve Reserve Banks located around the country and the Board of Governors in Washington, D.C.; and
WHEREAS:	The Federal Reserve System is an integral part of our U.S. government, performing valuable functions such as conducting monetary policy, promoting the stability of the financial system, promoting the safety and soundness of individual financial systems, fostering payment and settlement system safety and efficiency, and promoting consumer protection and community development; and
WHEREAS:	Through its six offices, the Sixth Federal Reserve District's tasks include distributing cash to banks and other depository institutions and processing electronic payments; and

**WHEREAS:** The Atlanta Fed also shares the Bank's research and expertise with the public through presentations, publications, community partnerships, and economic and financial education programs.
