Budget Timeline

January – April

- Budget Workshops
- City departments submit budgets
- Budget Office finalizes budget submission

May 1

Mayor presents preliminary budget to City Council

May – June

- Property Appraiser certifies taxable value of all property
- State provides revised revenue share estimates
- Mayor and Budget Office continue refinement of budget



Budget Timeline

July

- Mayor submits proposed budget to City Council
- City Council sets maximum millage rate

September – October


- City Council Finance Committee reviews proposed budget
- City Council holds public meetings, approves final budget

October 1

New fiscal year begins




Revenue Sources






General Fund Revenue Sources

City Faces \$40-60 M Gap in 10/11

- Primary drivers:
 - Employee related expenses currently negotiating
 - Health care costs
 - Public safety investments
 - Operational costs
- Assumes revenue-neutral property-tax rate



Five-Year Outlook

 Revenue will grow by 10 percent, while expenses grow by 35 percent

 76 percent of increase due to employeerelated costs

Projected \$200 million+ deficit in 2015




How Do We Close The Gap?


- Reduced employee-related costs

Millage Rates


