A. Social Media Discussion Review

The committee discussed the data received from the last meeting on Social Media. It appears that higher education, i.e. colleges and universities, are more involved with its students on this topic. The gap is with the lower education and public schools. There was no representation from Duval or St. Johns Counties. The Bridge of Northeast Florida attended to gather additional information on how other schools are handling social media and youth.

The committee agreed to the possibility of having the topic of social media included during the orientation and training sessions at the Mayor's Summer Hire Youth program and Corporate Hire program.
