Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 4:05 p.m. by Chair Alfreda Telfair.

Roll Call

Public Comments

Justin Bell addressed fellow Council members regarding last month's vote against Designated Proxies. Mr. Bell stated that had the motion not been defeated, every Planning Council member would have had the opportunity for representation at Council meetings where they were unable to attend. He stated that members should conduct the Council's business from a standpoint of representing the HIV community, and not from a purely personal view; part of this means reading and being familiar with the Planning Council packets before members arrive, so they will be knowledgeable of any upcoming votes.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was made and seconded to accept the October 24, 2013 Minutes as presented. The motion was carried.



 Justin contacted Audrey Gardner of NFAN, and NFAN may ask someone from Florida Medicaid to speak at one of their Friday luncheons.

1. Call to Order

5. Unfinished Business

Update on Condom Blast: Bonita Drayton attended a World AIDS Day committee meeting last week, and they will be coordinating a Condom Blast on Thursday, December 5. There will be four, possibly five vans going out into the community, doing HIV testing and distributing condoms. The goal is to distribute 10,000 condoms citywide on that day. The AIDS Program Office is requesting that if your agency normally hands out condoms, that you hold back two boxes for this event; they want to make sure we have an ample supply on hand that we can reach the 10,000 mark that day. The committee is looking at having testing vans in the 32207, 32211, 32210, 32244 zip codes, and the inner core areas of the City. This event will run from 11:00 a.m. to

around 8:00 p.m., and each van will be in several areas throughout the day; there will be two shifts covering the testing vans.

On Wednesday, November 13, we will be stuffing condom bags. We need a group of volunteers to help with this; we need small paper bags, snack bags, and condoms. The location is LSS Office on Philips Highway, and the time is 5:30 to 8:30 p.m.

6. New Business:

• Report on Upcoming Health Fairs/Events: Torrencia Shiloh reported that she hadn't received many health fair requests for November and December; it appears this is tapering off for the holidays. The two she did have for November were both for this Saturday, the 9th. The first one will be at Central CME Church on North Pearl Street, and the second one will be at Woodlawn Presbyterian on Woodlawn Road. Alfreda Telfair and Bonita both mentioned the Greater Church of God by Faith Thanksgiving Basket Drive that will be held also on the 9th from 10:00 to 3:00. W.A.C. participates in this Health Fair every year, and Alfreda will be taking some supplies with her when she leaves the meeting today.

Requests are expected to start up again around February, and Torrencia will keep the committee informed.

- <u>2014 W.A.C. Calendar</u>: Members reviewed future events coming up, and several were added to the list. March proves to be a busy month, with
 - (a) National Women & Girls HIV Awareness Day,
 - (b) National Week of Prayer for the Healing of AIDS,

 - (e) Health Fair at Washington Heights Apartments (which may be combined with Nat'l Women & Girls Awareness)

The W.A.C. committee might join forces with EIIHA and FCCAPP with the National HIV Testing Day event in June. Julie Cromer suggested the committee look at doing something during the Jazz Festival in late May.

Brief discussion on the 'I Never Asked brochure. Although the brochure is very
effective, we need to develop a script that follows through on the question you would
ask your partner, "What is your HIV status?" What if the partner refuses to answer, or
doesn't know his/her status, or the partner is positive, but lies about it?




