Honorable Members of the City Council City of Jacksonville

We have examined the accompanying statement of county funded court-related functions of the City of Jacksonville, Florida for the year ended September 30, 2013 pursuant to Section 29.0085 of the Florida Statutes. This statement is the responsibility of the management of the City's Finance Department. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this statement based on our examination.

Our examination was made in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, and accordingly, included such procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances. We believe that our examination provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

In our opinion, the statement referred to above is presented, in all material respects, in conformity with Sections 29.008 and 29.0085 of the Florida Statutes, except for the requirement to maintain the same funding level for "Lease/Rent Expense", "Utilities", "Communications Systems and Services Total" and "Existing Radio Systems" per F.S. 29.008(4)(a)&(c).

In reviewing the information on the 2012/13 report for the City of Jacksonville, we became aware of an issue with one line on last year's report. The "Security" line amounts for the Clerk of Circuit Courts and the State Courts columns were understated \$1,623,990.74 and \$6,318,564.04, respectively. The total funding provided for security should have been \$9,522,510.85 instead of \$1,579,956.07. These changes would not have impacted whether the City of Jacksonville met the funding requirements in the prior year. We do note the security line item was understated in prior years as well; however, based on our analysis it would not have switched the City from being compliant to noncompliant since at least the fiscal year ended September 30, 2009. We did not perform this review for years preceding the fiscal year ended September 30, 2009.
