



## What is the Edward Waters College Promise?

The EWC PROMISE is a commitment to “first-time-in-college” students having graduated from a local county high school seeking a four-year bachelor’s degree. 100 students are considered based on financial and transportation needs.

The Edward Waters College Promise Program is the **First Program** in the nation established by a four-year institution toward student debt elimination. It is the first Promise Program by a Historical Black College or University.

## Who is eligible to apply for The Promise?

The Promise serves the most financially at-risk students and works with need-based income thresholds for those who seek a degree in the fields of **Biology, Business, Communications, Criminal Justice, Elementary Education, Mathematics, Music, or Psychology**.

## How do you qualify for The Promise?

- Complete the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid Form (FAFSA)** and be eligible to receive the federal Pell grant. FAFSA website: [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) and EWC’s FAFSA code: **001478**.
- Receive an acceptance letter from the EWC Office of Admissions.
- **Must be** a commuter student.
