### **RE: FY 2014 Public Service Grant 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Programmatic Update**

Dear Council President Guillford,

In accordance with the request of the Finance Committee, the Public Service Grant Council ("PSGC") met and reviewed the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter's Programmatic accomplishments of the Public Service Grant agencies. Each of their reports is attached for your review.

This report is a summary of the accomplishments and services from October 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013 from the 31 contracted PSG programs across all three Priority Populations. These numbers represents the actual services provided with PSG funds.

Homeless- \$253,252 provided the following;

- 71,031 meals to homeless individuals
- 49 elderly received homebound meals daily
- 36,154 homeless intake assessments
- 42,951 nights of emergency shelter to 638 homeless individuals
- 514 individuals with temporary housing
- 157 individuals with permanent housing

Low-Income- \$189,685 provided the following:

- 140 individuals with training/assistance leading to employment
- 108 Case Management assessments
- 977 Case Management hours
- 14,461 bags of food to families in need
- 154,547 pounds of food distributed
- 29,641 calls for assistance with 15,563 referrals for Financial Assistance
- 211 Safety Planning Assessments
- 198 Low-Income individuals enrolled in literacy programs

Adults with Physical, Behavioral, Mental Disabilities- \$91,641 provided the following;

- 4,768 medical evaluations
- 338 hearing evaluations for ear aids
- 110 Disabled individuals enrolled in literacy programs
- 31 individuals received substance abuse treatment
- 64 Mental Health Screenings
- 311 screenings for vision resulting in 161 medical appointments

**Totaling \$534,578**
