RE: FY 2014 Public Service Grant 2nd Quarter Programmatic Update

Dear Council President Yarborough,

In accordance with the request of the Finance Committee, the Public Service Grant Council ("PSGC") met and reviewed the 2nd quarter's public service grant recipient's programmatic accomplishments. This report is a summary of the accomplishments from October 1, 2013 to March 31, 2014 from the 31 contracted PSG programs across all three Priority Populations. These numbers represents the actual services provided with PSG funds.

Homeless Persons & Families- **\$491,591** provided:

- 114 individuals with permanent housing
- 819 individuals with temporary housing
- 125 individuals obtained employment
- 69,491 meals & 171,396 pounds of food
- 3,463 homeless intake assessments
- 183,063 nights of emergency shelter to 182 homeless individuals

Low-Income Persons & Families **\$361,082** provided:

- 23 Household prevent from being homeless/ evicted
- 23 individuals gained employment
- 60 individuals with training/assistance leading to employment
- 244 medical follow-up appointments
- 30 hearing aids from the 702 hearing evaluations
- 632 Case Management hours
- 8,635 bags of food & 275,123 pounds of food
- 2,017 home delivered meals to seniors
- 56,263 calls for assistance with 28,727 referrals for financial assistance
- 54 Safety Planning Assessments
- 31 individuals received substance abuse treatment

Adults with Physical, Behavioral, and Mental Disabilities- **\$170,202** provided:

- 50 individuals with skills to gained employment
- 31 disabled individuals literacy training toward employment
- 382 Mental Health Screenings

Totaling \$1,022,874
