This meeting was brought to order by President Darien Glover at 12:06 p.m. Members of the council reviewed and approved the minutes.

After approving the minutes, the President introduced Ms. Hundley, who then introduced Mrs. Katrina Taylor, Director of School Behavioral Health in Duval County Public Schools. Mrs. Taylor began to discuss with the council about how common mental health was. The council then spoke about their feelings on the recent attacks in Florida, and how to improve the conversation on mental health at high schools. Ms. Taylor then asked the council about partnering with MYLAC at the Mind Over Matter Mental Health Conference event. The council discussed adding more students to attend the event, but the discussion was tabled until further information could be obtained. After the discussion, the council motioned to partner with Duval County Public Schools in the Mind/Matter Event. The motion was approved.

The council took a 10-minute break.

After the break, Mayors Report along with the President and Vice President reported to Dr. Moreland, a representative of the Mayor's office. They discussed the details of the Mind Over Matter Mental Health Conference, and their goals to write legislation for a potential teen center and mental health. Dr. Moreland gave the council advice to look at other places that have successfully created legislation and see what they are doing. From the discussion Dr. Moreland discussed the Mayor's priorities and how his priorities align with the council.

The council took a 10-minute break.

After the break, Brookie Brown along with other members who attended the Donna Run provided a summary of the event, and discussed how it inspired the members to continue participating in community events. Brookie also went to discuss pillars for partners of the Mayor's Young Leader Advisory Council. President Glover then presented a rough draft of a MYLAC brochure.
