This meeting was brought to order by President Darien Glover at 12:05 p.m. Members of the council reviewed and approved the minutes.

After approving the minutes Duval County Public Schools, Morgan Seiler School Behavioral Health, shared the survey question for the Mind over Matter event. A motion was made to amend the survey questions.
